Winemaker Notes:

Our Estate Cabernet represents our entire estate vineyard's *terroir* including seven different clones of Cabernet Sauvignon and our classic Petit Verdot from the deep, rocky soils of Block One.

The 2022 Estate Cabernet opens with enticing aromas of Santa Rosa plum, ripe red cherry and shaved chocolate, interwoven with hints of violet and vanilla bean. On the palate, it is both bright and lovely, with round structured tannins that offer a long, juicy finish. The harmonious balance of fruit and subtle oak nuances make it approachable now, while its vibrancy and youth promise excellent aging potential. Best

enjoyed from 2024 through 2040.

AVA: St. Helena, Napa Valley

Blend: 96% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Petit Verdot. 100% Estate Grown.

Vineyard: Saint Helena Estate is a thirteen-acre vineyard on the Napa Valley floor,

located on Pratt Avenue with Bale loam soils. Vines are cane pruned and hand-tended down to two clusters per shoot, yielding approximately two tons per acre. There are seven clones of Cabernet Sauvignon grown on the estate. The vineyard is managed by Lindsey Wallingford and our

estate crew.

Winemaking: Cold soak for 5 days. Post-fermentation maceration 14 days.

Racked twice.

Barrel Aging: 18 months in French oak barrels: Bossuet, Darnajou, Sylvain, Taransaud
