Winemaker Notes: The 2023 growing season in Napa Valley was refreshingly moderate, with a long, even ripening window, enhancing fruit freshness, aromatics, and phenolic complexity. The result is a vintage defined by finesse, vibrancy, and structural elegance.

The 2023 Estate Cabernet opens with expressive aromas of ripe blueberry, raspberry crème, and cocoa powder, underscored by a subtle floral lift and a note of classic graphite. On the palate, the wine reveals layers of lush purple fruit and dark chocolate, balanced by high-toned acidity and a supple tannin profile. Light on its feet yet flavorfully deep, this wine offers a lingering, mouth-coating finish with brightness and finesse.

Enjoy from 2025 through 2042.

AVA: St. Helena, Napa Valley

Blend: 92% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc, 3% Petit Verdot

Vineyard: Saint Helena Estate is a thirteen-acre vineyard on the Napa Valley floor, located on Pratt Avenue with Bale loam soils. Vines are cane pruned and hand-tended down to two clusters per shoot, yielding approximately two tons per acre. There are seven clones of Cabernet Sauvignon grown on the estate. The vineyard is managed by Lindsey Wallingford and our estate crew.

Winemaking: Cold soak for 5 days. Post-fermentation maceration 14 days. Racked twice.

Barrel Aging: 18 months in French oak barrels: Bossuet, Darnajou, Sylvain, Taransaud
